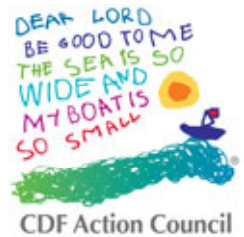


# Best and Worst U.S. Senators for Children
